

Successful Hezbawi Mekete Meeting

On 16th of January, 2010 Hezbawi Mekete Meeting was held in Stuttgart to discuss the UNSC Resolution 1907 of December 23, 2009 under the slogan “2010 is a Year of our Resolute of Development and Progress; and Foreign Interferences and Obstacles are signs of our Success in our endeavours for our Development and Growth Economically, Socially and Politically Resoluteness.”

More than 500 Eritreans attended the meeting, On the occasion Mr. Petros Tsegai ambassador of Eritrea to Germany participated the meeting and he briefed and updated the attendants the current events and the challenges ahead of us. Moreover he stated that the shameful and unjust UNSC resolution to sanction Eritrea is an extension of the undeclared sanction. He assured the participants of the meeting as usual as with our experience of 30 years of successful struggle with well organized efforts, devotion and determination that shall overcome and prevail without doubt.

Following the briefing of Ambassador Mr. Petros Tsegai, Mr. Berhane Zere head of the community and social affairs presented a paper with a title “18 Years under the umbrella of Independence”. He briefed the audience the peculiarities of Eritrea in its struggle before and after independence as a nation in comparison to other African countries in all sectors of economy as per our vision and ambitions.

Under the title “Miscarriage of Justice” Dr. Ammanuel Tukue” discussed the shameful resolution said passed by the UNSC was designed, choreographed and sponsored by the misguided United States erroneous foreign policy. The unfounded accusation is based on deceit, fabrication of lies by surrogate puppet governments of Ethiopia and Uganda as per the assignments given to them by the USA state department with the disgruntled Ambassador to UN “Susan Rice “ which she had grudges with the GOE and people. However, he further stated that the abuse of being a super power by USA for its unjust decisions is not new to Eritreans.

Apart from this finally Dr. Ammanuel Tukue stated that the big progress Eritrea is making with self-reliance for economic independence was intentionally misrepresented that Eritrea is becoming “A bad example of Good”, to other developing countries. With commitment, coordinated struggle and challenges he asserted with confidence that we will overcome any obstacles and hurdles and our developmental progress will never be deterred.

Following, the presentations the attendants condemn USA administration for repeating second historical shameful unjust decisions on Eritrea with deceit. Despite all the hurdles and obstacles planed by the USA administration such deceitful decisions will strength their commitment to their unity and devotion to their country.

Moreover, the attendants of the Hizbawi Mekete admired the Government of Eritrea for not putting in bargain the sovereignty and values of Eritrea. The decision of the GOE for self reliance, political and economic independence and the role Eritrea is playing to secure peace and stability in the region and beyond. As a result they reiterated their support for the Eritrean Defence Force and assured their commitment and readiness for any call by the GOE for any eventualities.

The Hizbawi Mekete attendants meeting was concluded by passing a resolution based on the enthusiastic national feelings discussions during the event.

Resolutions of Hezbawi Mekete

1. We condemn the resolution of December 23.2009 said passé by UNSC 1907/2009 and we call to be annulled and revoked.
2. We support the GOE for its resolute stances to safeguard the integrity and sovereignty of Eritrea despite all the sabotages, hurdles and obstacles by our enemies. Apart from this the political and economic independence policies followed by the government is exemplary. In addition we admire and support the policy of self reliance in food production. We are very inspired with appreciation by the infrastructure constructed and other development and progress made in different sectors of the economy, as a result we condemn all elements who hinder our progress and we renew our promises to challenge all our adversaries by all means at our disposal.

In all corners of the globe and in particular in the horn of Africa all the mayhems, disaster and the bloodshed occurring in Somalia is due erroneous foreign policies of United States of America administration. We acknowledge the role Eritrean is playing in securing peace and harmony in the horn of Africa and beyond.

If the security council has to stand to its name and obligation to secure peace in the horn of Africa it is supposed to implement the Algiers Agreement decided by EEBC i.e. to oblige Ethiopia to abide by the decision which is final and binding and signed by the UN and other regional institutions as guarantors. We call also call the United Nations Security Council not to show a double standard.
5. We call to the International Community to bring to the International Tribune the despot and puppet government of Ethiopia for invading Somalia, for genocide, rape, mayhem and displacement of hundred thousands of civilians.
6. Currently our nation Eritrea is facing many problems challenging our sovereignty. Foreign interferences has long history in Eritrea. We are ready for any call to support morally and/or materially.
7. We call all Eritreans inside Eritrea and Diaspora and all peace loving people of the world to stand with for the truth and justice to denounce the shameful and unjust UNSC resolution 1907/2009. We appreciate and acknowledge all who oppose and denounce the resolution; we remind to continue to challenge it through concerted and organized form.
